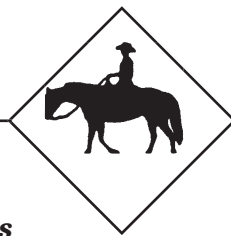


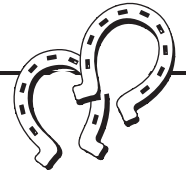
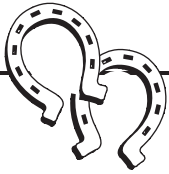

Beginners:

For children 6 years and older with some horse experience. Basic horse care and maintenance, equipment identification, arts and crafts. A one hour group riding lesson will be taught every day. Session ends with a Horse Show and pizza party.

**Intermediate/
Advanced:**

For children 8 years old and older who possess the skills to handle a horse at a walk, trot and canter. Each child is assigned their own horse for the week. Arts and crafts and a one hour group riding lesson each day. Session ends with a horse show and a pizza party.

**If signing up for this week, you must come for one riding lesson, so that you can be evaluated.*
